



RS TERA WORLD CHALLENGE TROPHY

PROGRAMME

We are delighted that the 2019 World Challenge Trophy will take place in Ljungskile Sweden.

This year we have **85** competitors from **9** countries.

The Sailing Instructions are published on the International RS Tera Class Association website. There will be no copies handed out at registration, but a copy will be posted on the Club's Official Notice Board.

Registration will take place in the Ljungskile Segelsällskap (LjSS) clubhouse at the following time:

Sunday August 4th 08.00 to 20.00

Please remember that the annual €15 membership fee to the International RS Tera Class Association must be paid at registration.

Following registration, please take your sail to the Scrutineering Tent where the measurement team will attach a country flag on your sail.

These events rely on volunteers, so please email me if you are able to help with registration and as crew on the numerous safety and support boats.

Extra tickets for the Sailors dinner on Tuesday 6th will be available for sale during registration. Mussels will be freshly cooked on stage by the restaurant MUSSELBAREN, with local hamburgers also available. Sailors tickets are included in the entry fee and will be handed out at registration.

Scrutineering/Measurement

A number of boats will be randomly selected for inspection and competitors will be informed at registration.

Support boats

All support boats must register in advance of the event with the IRSTCA Secretary, Emma Hawley at intsecretary@rstera.org. Upon arrival Support boats must report to Ljungskile Segelsällskap Regatta Office. They must not launch before this requirement has been met. All support boats must register in the regatta office during the registration times. In addition, all support boats are required to display an identification flag whenever on the water during the event.

Arrival & departure – PLEASE READ & USE EVENT MAP FOR REFERENCE

The event area is a complete car free zone between **15:00 Saturday August 3rd & 20:00 Friday 9th**. Boats can be dropped off & then picked up at the club at key times but cars must immediately be moved to the car park. Thereafter cars must also be left in the event car park each day & sailors & families walk to the club (200 metres).

Arrival

The event village will be set up on Friday 2nd August so the dinghy park & areas around the sailing club will be extremely busy. If you arrive on Friday or Saturday before 3pm, please park cars & boat



trailers in the first large car park on the right (see event map on International website) & walk to the club. Myself or Helena will be around to direct where you can put your boats. This is a public area & we only get exclusive access from 3pm Saturday when the public road to the sailing club is closed to event traffic only. At this time, you can drive up to the club and unloading will take place in the drop off zone beside the dinghy park & event tent (see event map).

Charters & private boats shipped to Sweden will be unloaded in the trailer park beside the clubhouse. Sailors need to unpack their own boats.

Departure

After final racing on the 9th, boats should be wheeled on trollies to the far trailer park for packing away & towing off site. Charter & private boats need to be re-packed in the trailer park beside the club house.
